Membership Descriptions

***OPTION I - REGULAR MEMBERSHIP:** Regular membership is when an individual chooses to join ISM-Philadelphia, Inc. and ISM-National. ISM-Philadelphia will set the annual dues for its local membership, which will include ISM dues. Any individual that chooses this type of membership will receive discounts on both ISM and Affiliate levels.

****OPTION II - ASSOCIATE MEMBER:** Associate Membership is available to those persons who meet eligibility standards of ISM-Philadelphia, provided that at least one other person of the same company division holds a regular (full) membership in the ISM-Philadelphia, Inc. Not more than six Associate Memberships can be available per company division for each regular member.

- Associate Members shall have all benefits and privileges accorded Regular Members except they shall not be permitted to vote or hold office or chair a group or committee. Because Associate Membership does not include membership in ISM, Associate Members shall pay the same entrance fee and annual dues as regular members, except for ISM dues.
- Associate Members may convert to full membership upon payment of regular membership dues pro-rata. However, no person holding regular (full) membership will be eligible for conversion to Associate Membership except when he/she is in good standing and at the completion of his/her current paid-up dues period. No interim refund or dues adjustment will be made.
- In any situation involving Associate Members, if the Regular (full) Member of such company organization resigns his/her regular membership, at least one of the Associate Members of that organization component must convert to regular membership at the beginning of the next dues period.

Dues, contributions, or gifts to this organization are not tax-deductible charitable contributions for income tax purposes. Dues may, however, be deductible as a business expense.
